The St. Lucia Citizenship by Investment Program is regulated by the Citizenship by Investment Act No. 14 of 2015.

- Investment bonds.
- Participation in an approved enterprise project.

- The Saint Lucian passport is currently ranked 35th among global passports.
- Saint Lucian passport holders, who may travel visa-free to 143 countries (UK , Ireland, Schengen Area, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore ) and other countries.
- Enjoy the ability to pass down citizenship to future generations, promoting solidarity and opening doors for the entire family.
- Maximize your financial success by benefiting from a progressive tax structure and offshore banking services.
- Applicants are able to include a spouse, children under 31, siblings under 18, and parents aged 55 and over, as well as to add dependents after they have been granted citizenship.



# REQUIREMENTS OF SAINT LUCIA

## Citizenship

- The main applicant must be at least 18 years .
- Must possess a clean criminal record for anyone above 16.
- Must not have rejected visa entry to any of the countries of which St. Lucia enjoys a visa-free entry .
